Welcome to the PDF that explains the GROUP workspaces. GROUP workspaces are private, which means only approved members can view and participate in them. This privacy enables you to work without constantly worrying about what non-invited members think. GROUP workspaces are similar to factories, which are efficient but not always pretty. The main purpose is to deliver results as quickly and reliably as possible. Some of the information, for instance results, are then shared for everyone to see in designated public workspaces. GROUPS do make provision for record keeping and provide for monitoring by VIPs.

GROUPS function as the 'engine room' for development collaboration, where the bulk of the work gets done, where quality and productivity are priorities. These workspaces are therefore packed with many tools to speed up collaboration and enhance quality and productivity. Different activities require different tool sets. We therefore offer 6 standard GROUPS for popular types of activity. The six standard groups are:
